## <u>Item No. (3) Homelessness Committee – Chair, Ray Cole</u> (21-056) Council File 21-0063 – Underutilized City Owned Land

Discussion and possible action:

To: Los Angeles City Council

From: Woodland Hills-Warner Center Neighborhood Council (WHWCNC)

Re: Council File 21-0063 City-Owned Properties / Unused / Underutilized / Homeless Housing

Motion for the board of the Woodland Hills-Warner Center Neighborhood Council to SUPPORT Council File 21-0063, which directs all city departments that own land to provide reports on the underutilization of that land and the feasibility of using them for temporary or permanent homeless housing and directs the Department of General Services to evaluate leases to outside entities to determine if they can be modified for the purposes of using said land to homeless individuals and families.

WHEREAS, the city of Los Angeles owns more than 470 sq. miles of land, which is primarily "utilized for libraries, parks, police stations, and fire stations."

WHEREAS, by the Los Angeles City Council's own admission, "The City" owns a "sizable amount of land [that is] unused or underutilized."

WHEREAS, the waitlist for federal housing vouchers is over a decade long with many of those vouchers expire before they can be used due individuals NOT being able to find landlords willing to accept such vouchers.

WHEREAS, over 500K evictions in Los Angeles County between 2010-2018, contributed to the increase in individuals and families becoming homeless.

WHEREAS, Los Angeles is third nationwide in terms of housing not being affordability, with housed individuals spending more than 30% of their monthly income on housing, which places them in jeopardy of becoming homeless were they to experience a strain in their monthly income from unforeseen familial events.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the Woodland Hills-Warner Center Homelessness Committee recommends that the Board of Woodland Hills-Warner Center Neighborhood Council supports Council File 21-0063.
