**Neighborhood Council Action Plan**

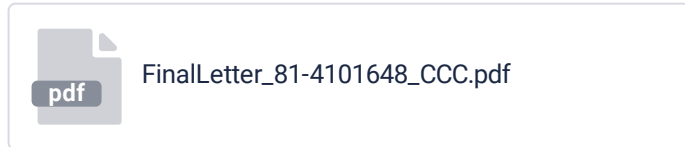

CCC Goodies to Go will purchase the items in bulk and distribute to the selected hospitals using their volunteers and/or service providers.
