The West Valley Food Pantry is a 501c3 affiliated with the Prince of Peace Episcopal Church providing food to people in

twelve zip codes that cover the West San Fernando Valley. They have aligned with the Los Angeles Regional Food Bank during the Covid-19 response and are providing food for up to 600 people a day.

Neighborhood Council Action Plan

The Woodland Hills-Warner Center proposes to provide funding of \$1,000.00 (One Thousand Dollars) to be used to help the pantry purchase additional food products to support the increased need for support - particularly for young families that are first-time users of the food bank, but who are under extreme financial pressure due to job losses.

The WVFP serves up to 600 people (150-200 car loads) per day.

Social distancing is practiced in accordance with LA County Health and LA City directives.
