Shelters required before people can be removed from the underpasses. CD3 has achieved this in 4 areas (Canoga Park, Winnetka, Reseda). Winnetka underpass can be cleared in mid-November). May 2021 to be able to clear all underpasses. Initial are Corbin and Winnetka. Numerous programs including cabin communities. Only 1 shelter west of the 405 - family only. CD3 Staff Provided a response including housing status.
